BEECH SPRINGS CAMP

Greetings from Beech Springs Camp! We are gearing up for a busy spring season and preparing for summer camp already. There are facilities at camp that will require some help to be ready and useable this summer, and I wanted to address that with you. The purpose then, of this month's article, is to make you aware of a need that we have, specifically, in our facility we call Magnolia Lodge. This facility is our only "over-night" accommodation that has regular beds in it. All other accommodations at camp use bunk beds. So, Magnolia Lodge has always been more of an adult facility and is seldom used to house children. The Lodge is kind of like a little motel. There are 16 rooms in this facility and each room has a queen size bed and a full size one. The exception is the "speaker's room," which has only one bed and a small desk where a speaker could study and prepare a message.





The linens, pillows, and comforters on the beds are terribly old and very worn. Our best estimate is that the linens are at least 20 years old. Recently, while cleaning the building, we noticed a bed sheet that was stained, extremely thin, and thread bare due to age and use. To be quite honest, it was embarrassing to me as a host to outside groups using the building, that somehow I hadn't seen this sooner. Even after running the sheet through the washing machine and knowing it was clean, the stains would not come out. After a complete inventory of all our linens I realized they all need to be replaced.

I asked one of the members of our Camp Ministry Team to research an estimated replacement cost. In the process of getting this estimate I learned some things about how the quality of a sheet is rated according to thread-count.

It was determined we would need about \$300 per room to change out all the linens and pillows. The cost to change out the entire building, including tax, is a little over \$5,000. Would your church be willing to help us finance this project? Could you pay for a room or more? Our plan is to raise the monies we need and buy all the linens at one time to ensure uniformity and maybe even get a discount by buying in bulk. I hope we can accomplish this project before June 1 when summer camp begins. Thank you for considering this project, we need your help!
